I use \circ for several things: ① an enclosed or defined space area (like commit (omit, miss send) or penetrate).

② to indicate a "2nd" of an id: attract and respond or other react else (a 2nd is a way to use the same id for a word with the same meaning, to avoid having to make a completely new id).

③ As a generalized thing (which is like an enclosed or defined area).

\circ^{ch} characteristic [Greek: charac etch]

\circ^{adj} adjunct [Latin: junct join, yoke]

\circ^{feat} feature (a part or shine glow marks)

\circ^{func} function [fung work, perform]

\circ^{prop} property (3 roads)
