

I made a comment on a Dr. Joseph Suglia interview + wrote that I would make a post re my comment, so here (gesagt, getan!) it goes:

The first id that comes to mind that I just created spontaneously + seemed to "click" (I liked it and it seemed to fit for unknown reasons) is for "perfect". I associate a circle with perfection + the little circle at the top seems to indicate "most" + "highest" + intensified. Maybe the image of the "buddha figure" in the Mandelbrot set affected me - I don't know.

I just a few minutes ago made a new id for "now" - a time indicator sun, I like it because it shows the effulgent gleaming brightness of the present moment.

It is more alive + connected metaphorically than my usual Φ . I also like \odot for "now" - time or distance line with a circled dot. I rationalized my liking for it by noting that \odot is "I", so it connects "now" with "I". How could there

be a "now" without the inner sun of the self, of "I"? This insight from Nisargadatta Maharaj (I AM THAT).
